Thanks to our supporters, LTLT ended 2012 with a bang! We celebrated both the strongest fundraising year in our history as well as the protection of over 900 acres with pristine headwater streams in the Snowbird Mountains of Cherokee County, North Carolina.

LTLT worked with the Town of Andrews and the N.C. Clean Water Management Trust Fund to conserve the town's 917 acre water source. The project conserves 7.3 miles of streams along with 5.6 miles of National Forest boundary overlooking the historic Valley River. Over the past several years LTLT has helped to conserve over 10,000 acres of municipally-owned watershed lands of the towns of Waynesville, Sylva, Bryson City, Murphy and Andrews.
